Types of Post-Study Work Visas in the Australia

Australia continues to be a top destination for international students, with increasing opportunities for graduates to stay and work after completing their studies. In 2023, over 50,000 Indian students were granted post-study work visas, reflecting the country's thriving job market and demand for skilled professionals.

Here are the post-study work visa options in Australia:

- **Temporary Graduate Visa (subclass 485) – Graduate Work Stream**

Eligibility: For international students who have completed a qualification that relates to an occupation on Australia's Skilled Occupation List.

Duration: 18 months.

Purpose: Allows graduates to work in Australia in a skilled occupation for up to 18 months while gaining valuable work experience.

- **Temporary Graduate Visa (subclass 485) – Post-Study Work Stream**

Eligibility: For graduates who have completed a higher education qualification (bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degree) in Australia.

Duration: 2 to 4 years, depending on the qualification level (2 years for bachelor's or master's, 4 years for PhD).

Purpose: Allows graduates to live, work, and travel in Australia after completing their studies. It provides a pathway to gain work experience in Australia, which can be essential for future skilled migration.

- **Skilled Employer Sponsored Regional Visa (subclass 494)**

Eligibility: For graduates who have a job offer from an employer in a designated regional area of Australia.

Duration: 5 years.

Purpose: Allows graduates to work in a regional area of Australia for an approved employer. This visa offers a pathway to permanent residency if certain requirements are met after 3 years.
