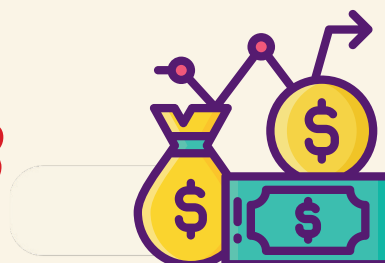

 - Home/International Students: AED 40,000 to AED 90,000 per year (depending on the program)
- Postgraduate:
 - Home/International Students: AED 50,000 to AED 100,000 per year (depending on the program)

Cost of Living:

- Dubai: AED 3,500 to AED 7,000 per month (accommodation, food, etc.)

Types of Post-Study Work Visas in the Dubai

Dubai has become a popular destination for international graduates, offering various post-study work options to support students in building their careers. In 2023, a growing number of graduates from India chose Dubai as their post-study destination.

Here are the post-study work visa options in Dubai:

- **Post-Graduation Work Visa**

Eligibility: For graduates from UAE-based universities or institutions.

Duration: Up to 1-2 years (depending on the university and program).

Purpose: Allows graduates to stay and work in Dubai without needing a sponsor, offering the flexibility to find work across various sectors.

- **Golden Visa**

Eligibility: For high-skilled professionals, investors, and entrepreneurs.

Duration: 5 to 10 years.

Purpose: Offers long-term residency for those with high-value skills or significant contributions to the economy.

Duration: 1 to 3 years.

Purpose: Allows graduates to operate as freelancers, providing the flexibility to work on a contract basis without being tied to one employer.
