- Public Universities:
 - Public Universities €0 to €3,000 per year for both undergraduate and postgraduate programs (administrative fees may apply).
- Private Universities:
 - Private Universities: €10,000 to €20,000 per year (depending on the course).

Cost of Living:

- Berlin & Other Cities: €934 to €1,300 per month (includes accommodation, food, etc).

Types of Post-Study Work Visas in the Germany

Germany offers excellent opportunities for international graduates to stay and work after completing their education.

Types of Post-Study Work Visas in Germany

- **Job Seeker Visa**

Eligibility: Graduates from German universities.

Duration: Up to 18 months.

Purpose: Allows graduates to stay in Germany to search for jobs relevant to their qualifications.

- **Residence Permit for Employment**

Eligibility: Graduates with a job offer related to their field of study.

Duration: Up to 4 years, depending on the contract.

Purpose: Enables graduates to gain practical experience and contribute to the German economy.

- **EU Blue Card**

Eligibility: Graduates with a job offer in Germany with an annual salary threshold (typically €56,400 or €43,992 for shortage occupations like IT, engineering, and healthcare).

Duration: Up to 4 years.

Purpose: Allows highly skilled professionals to work and eventually apply for permanent residency.
