Types of Post-Study Work Visas in New Zealand

- **Post-Study Work Visa (Open)**

Eligibility: For international students who have completed a qualification at Level 4 or above on the New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF).

Duration: Up to 3 years.

Purpose: This visa allows graduates to work for any employer in any role. It provides flexibility as there is no specific employer requirement, making it ideal for graduates looking to gain work experience in New Zealand.

- **Post-Study Work Visa (Employer-Assisted)**

Eligibility: For graduates who have a job offer from a New Zealand employer that is relevant to their qualification.

Duration: 1 to 2 years, depending on the qualification and job offer.

Purpose: This visa allows graduates to work in a job that matches their qualification with a New Zealand employer. It provides an opportunity to gain practical experience and potentially transition to a longer-term visa.

- **Accredited Employer Work Visa**

Eligibility: For graduates who have a job offer from an accredited employer in New Zealand.

Duration: Up to 3 years.
