Types of Post-Study Work Visas in the UK

The UK remains a top choice for international students, offering world-class education and excellent career prospects. In 2023, over 100,000 Indian students received Graduate Route visas, allowing them to stay and work in the UK after completing their studies. With a growing demand for skilled professionals across various sectors, the UK provides a strong pathway for international graduates to build successful careers. Graduate Visa (Post-Study Work Visa)

Here are the post-study work visa options in UK:

- **Graduate Visa (Post-Study Work Visa)**

Eligibility: For international students who have completed an eligible course at the undergraduate level or above in the UK.

Duration: Up to 2 years (3 years for doctoral graduates).

Purpose: Allows graduates to work at any skill level or look for a job in the UK after completing their studies.

- **Skilled Worker Visa**

Eligibility: For graduates who secure a job offer from an approved UK employer at the required skill level.

Minimum Salary: £26,200 per year (or £10.75 per hour, depending on the job).

Duration: Up to 5 years.

Purpose: This visa allows graduates to live and work in the UK in skilled roles and may lead to permanent residency.

- **Health and Care Worker Visa**

Eligibility: For graduates with job offers in the health and care sectors (e.g., healthcare professionals, social workers).

Minimum Salary: £20,000 - £22,000 per year (varies by role).

Duration: Up to 5 years.

Purpose: This visa provides an easier route for graduates entering the essential healthcare industry.
