Types of Post-Study Work Visas in the USA

The USA remains a top destination for international students, offering world-class education and excellent career opportunities. In 2023, thousands of Indian students secured Optional Practical Training (OPT) opportunities, allowing them to gain valuable work experience in the U.S. after completing their studies. With a strong economy and high demand for skilled professionals in fields like technology, healthcare, and engineering, the USA provides a clear pathway for international graduates to build successful careers and even transition to H-1B work visas and permanent residency.

Types of Post-Study Work Visas in USA

OPT Programs allows International students in the U.S. have the opportunity to work after completing their degree, students can take advantage of the Optional Practical Training (OPT) program, which allows them to work in the U.S. for up to one year in their field of study.

STEM OPT Extensions: For students with degrees in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) fields, the OPT period is extended to 36 months.

H1B Visa: Upon completing OPT, students can apply for an H1B visa (work permit visa) by securing a job offer from a U.S. employer in a related field to continue working in the U.S. long-term.

The H-1B visa allows an initial stay of 3 years, extendable up to 6 years.
